If a pitcher reaches his/her threshold while facing a batter, the pitcher may continue to pitch until any one of the following conditions occurs:

- 1. That batter reaches base;
- 2. That batter is put out;
- 3. The third out is made to complete the half inning.

If a pitcher reached a day(s) of rest threshold while facing a batter, the pitcher may continue to pitch until one of the following conditions occurs: 1. The batter reaches base; 2. That batter is retired; 3. The third out is made to complete the half-inning. The pitcher will only be required to observe the calendar day(s) of rest for the threshold he/she reached during that at-bat, provided that pitcher is removed before delivering a pitch to another batter. For example, a pitcher starts a batter with 49 pitches. He retires the batter on the 53rd pitch. If removed from the game, his pitch count would revert back to the threshold reached, 50, and he would only be required to have 2 days of rest.
